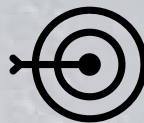
Project Overview

The grant recipient will prioritize individuals who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted Unemployment Insurance (UI) or other Pandemic UI programs. The grant recipient will also serve young women, women of color, and long-term unemployed parents.



Project Description

The project plans to address workforce challenges for parents and women through career and training services, internships, and work experiences (including transitional jobs); provide supportive services such as extended childcare, mental health services, and career transition support.



Project Goals

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted UI or other COVID-19-related UI programs.
