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# Project Overview

The grant recipient will prioritize service delivery to individuals living in poverty, military combat veterans, racial/cultural and ethnic minorities, felons, senior citizens, disabled and women.



## **Project Description**

The program plans to implement a service model for skills enhancement and retraining services so that participants who lost their jobs due to the pandemic can compete in the labor market and re-employ themselves; upgrade website to be interactive and bilingual (Spanish/English); and expand outreach and strategic partnerships to avoid duplication of services and facilitate employability of dislocated workers.



### **Project Goals**

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted Unemployment Insurance (UI) or other COVID-19related UI programs.
