Project Description

The program plans to implement a service model for skills enhancement and retraining services so that participants who lost their jobs due to the pandemic can compete in the labor market and re-employ themselves; upgrade website to be interactive and bilingual (Spanish/English); and expand outreach and strategic partnerships to avoid duplication of services and facilitate employability of dislocated workers.



Project Goals

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted Unemployment Insurance (UI) or other COVID-19-related UI programs.
