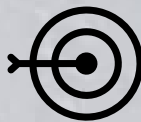
Project Overview

The program plans to develop Wisconsin's online systems, platforms, and data structure to engage in evidence based practices related to help reemploy dislocated workers affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic and serve historically-marginalized communities and groups.

The goal of the program is to help reemploy dislocated workers most affected by the economic and employment fallout from the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular those from historically marginalized communities or groups, and those who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted Unemployment Insurance (UI) or other COVID-19-related UI programs.
