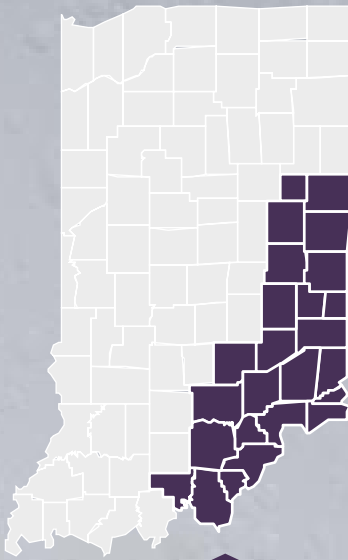

### Project Overview

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services declared the opioid crisis a national public health emergency in October 2017. The grant will serve approximately 450 participants from 25 counties impacted by the health and economic effects of widespread opioid use, addiction, and overdose. The funding will also provide employment services to reintegrate individuals impacted by the crisis.



### Project Description

This grant will provide eligible participants with disaster-relief employment in jobs addressing the crisis, such as community health workers, recovery coaches, and peer navigators to help individuals travel the path to recovery. The project will also assist eligible individuals directly impacted by the crisis with reintegration into the workforce, providing them opportunities for work-based training and placement in high-wage, in-demand occupations.
