

Economic Transition Factors

In May 2018, Garelick Farms announced that it would close its Lynn facility due to a weakening demand for milk products, and also due to the company's consolidation of production activity to another facility in Franklin, MA.



Proposal Summary

The Massachusetts application for DWG funding plans to provide approximately 130 of the 230 affected workers with the services required for self-sustaining reemployment. Examples of such services include classes for English as a Second Language and Adult Basic Education, as well as skills training for jobs in high-growth sectors



Proposed Outcome

The affected workers will be able to find new employment that will provide them with a living wage. They will not only be able to sustain themselves and their families, but they will also find fulfillment in their jobs.



Sectors of Focus

The sectors of focus include health care, advanced manufacturing, financial services, and the construction trades.
