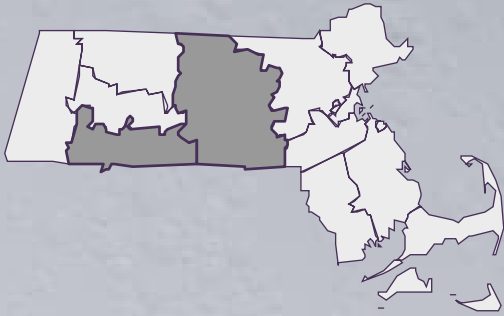

Project Overview

The U.S Department of Health and Human Services declared the opioid crisis a national public health emergency in October 2017. The Massachusetts Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development submitted an application requesting \$2,032,071 for a NHE DWG. The project will provide disaster-relief jobs and employment services to eligible individuals in the Massachusetts communities impacted by the epidemic.



Project Description

This grant will provide eligible participants with disaster-relief employment addressing the crisis, establishing peer recovery positions to help opioid-affected individuals gain access to resources and navigate a path to recovery. The grant will also provide employment and training services to reintegrate eligible individuals back into the workforce.
