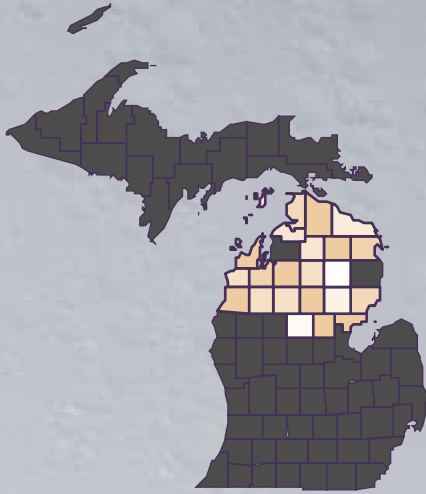


# National Health Emergency Dislocated Worker Grants

### Project Overview

The proposed project will provide disaster-relief jobs, along with employment and training services, to eligible individuals in Michigan communities impacted by the health and economic effects of widespread opioid use, addiction, and overdose.



### Project Description

This grant will provide eligible participants with disaster-relief employment as Life Coaches, who connect opioid-affected individuals with an array of mental health and social services addressing both recovery and reemployment. The project also provides employment and training services to individuals affected by the opioid crisis and to individuals transitioning into healthcare positions related to addiction, treatment, prevention, and pain management. The project will be operated by an alliance of three Michigan Works! Agencies serving eligible grant participants in 24 counties in Northern Lower Michigan.
