

Project Overview

The Missouri Division of Workforce Development submitted an application requesting funding to support a National Emergency Grant project providing disaster-relief jobs and employment services to eligible individuals in the Missouri counties that have been impacted by the health and economic effects of widespread opioid use.



Project Description

The proposed grant of up to \$4,090,306, will serve approximately 160 participants from 51 central and southeastern counties impacted by the health and economic effects of widespread opioid use, addiction, and overdose. The funding will also provide employment services to individuals seeking careers in healthcare professions related to addiction, treatment, prevention and pain management.
