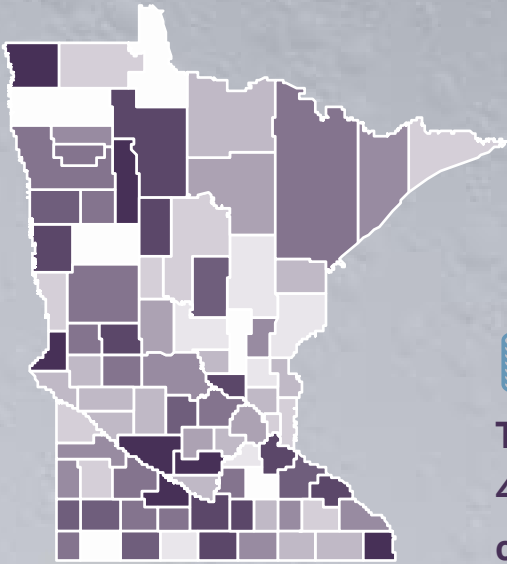


National Health Emergency Dislocated Worker Grants

Project Overview

This grant will serve approximately 200 participants from 46 counties impacted by the health and economic effects of opioid use. The proposed project will provide disaster-relief jobs, along with employment and training services, to eligible individuals in Minnesota communities affected by the health and economic effects of widespread opioid use, addiction, and overdose.

Project Description

This grant will provide eligible participants with disaster-relief employment in peer support counseling positions focusing on addressing the unique recovery needs of individuals affected by opioid use and on the brink of homelessness. The project will also assist eligible individuals directly impacted by the crisis with reintegration into the workforce, providing them employment and training services to prepare them for self-sustaining employment critical to a stable recovery.
