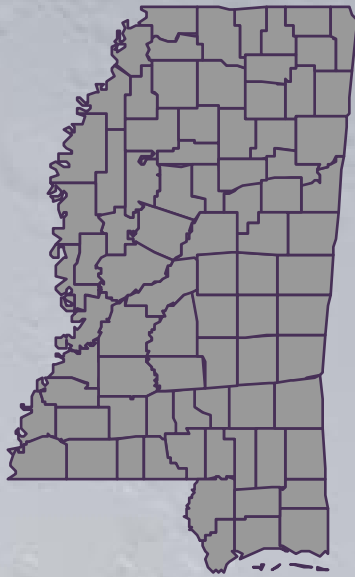

Project Overview

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services declared the opioid crisis a national public health emergency in October 2017. The Mississippi Department of Employment Security submitted an application requesting \$4,710,000 to receive the NHE DWG, to provide disaster-relief jobs and employment services to eligible individuals in the MS communities impacted by this epidemic.



Project Description

This grant will provide eligible participants with disaster-relief employment to address the crisis by establishing peer recovery positions to assist opioid-impacted individuals gain access to resources and navigate a path to recovery. The grant will also provide employment and training services to reintegrate eligible individuals back into the workforce.
