



According to a study done by Prudential Financial and Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans of America in 2016, nearly 2/3 of all new veterans say they faced a difficult transition from military to civilian life primarily because they feel they may be speaking a different language than the business leaders who may hire them. The civilian business community does not understand military service skills and how to translate them.
