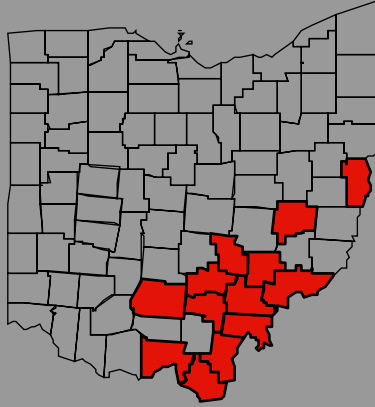

## Qualifying Events

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services submitted a request for a total of \$9,450,000, to assist with clean-up and recovery efforts resulting from severe storms in 13 southern Ohio counties.






## Proposal Summary

Between February 14 - 25, 2018, the southern part of Ohio suffered severe storms and mudslides. FEMA declared it a major disaster, *Ohio Severe Storms, Landslides, and Mudslides* (DR-4360). This declaration enables the state to request DWG funding for the clean-up efforts.



## Project Description

The state will use the funding to provide disaster relief employment for projects addressing the clean-up resulting from downed trees, as well as from flood debris impacting bridges, culverts, ditches, roadways, and waterways. 300 eligible individuals will assist with the clean-up.
