


# Economic Recovery Dislocated Worker Grant

### Economic Transition Factors

GE announced the current layoffs occurring at the Erie facility via a Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act notice, which was issued on November 6, 2015. The affected workers were engaged in activities related to the manufacture of marine and stationary drills, train locomotives, and off-highway vehicles.



### Proposal Summary

The affected workers have been certified as eligible for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA), and this proposed project will provide these individuals with “wrap-around” and supportive services that are not offered through the TAA program, in order to assist them in the completion of their training programs. It also provides for participants to partake in new entrepreneurship coursework that incorporates skills training, as well as coaching on adherence to a mindset that facilitates success.



### Proposed Outcome

This project will incorporate the new Ice House Entrepreneurship Program, which utilizes trained facilitators to conduct seminars for affected workers in order to supplement skills training, foster entrepreneurial thinking, and to support participants in less tangible ways so that they may establish a mindset that will lead to success.
