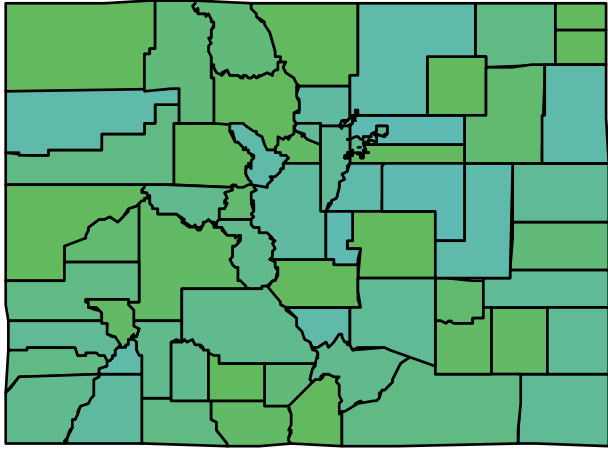

Project Overview

Employment and training activities will include enhanced career and supportive services and occupational training that emphasizes work-based learning through job shadowing, internships, and Registered Apprenticeships combined with short-term credential programs to more quickly gain the skills, knowledge, and experience necessary to qualify for and to succeed in safe and sustainable high-quality jobs in growth industries. Disaster relief employment positions will support Care Economy-related sectors, particularly in rural areas, such as healthcare, child care, and early childhood development, allowing more workers to return to re-enter the workforce.
