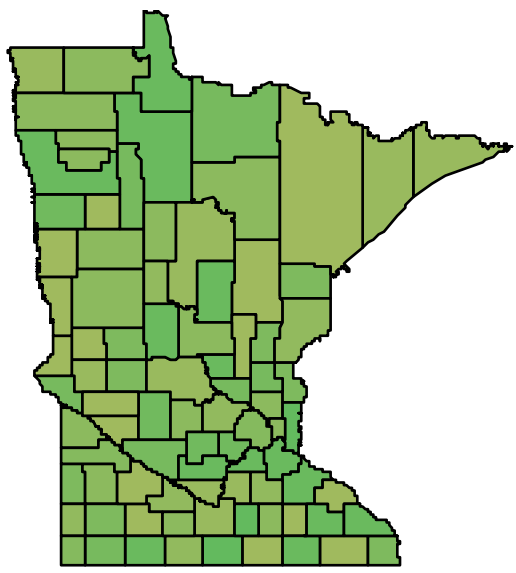

Project Overview

Proposed project will work toward filling high quality, in demand jobs by providing the Native American population education/training and job support to ensure successful employment outcomes. It is anticipated that the project will produce improved individual community resilience to the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic by reducing the social and economic disparities through high paying jobs obtained by clients as a result of their participation in the project's training and education opportunities.



Project Description

Employment and training activities will include career development, employability skills, financial literacy courses, transportation and logistics classroom, and hands-on training for OSHA 30, First AID/CPR, and Class B CDL with Bus Driver Endorsement certifications. Disaster relief employment activities will include hiring ten local workers to respond to disaster events while gaining valuable work skills.
