The goal of the WORC grants is to create economic prosperity and gainful employment opportunities for eligible residents in impacted ARC and DRA regions, enabling them to remain and thrive in these communities. The proposed project will address training for three high-demand occupations, including Agriculture, Healthcare/Social Worker (Community Health Worker) and Information Technology Support. The high percentage of the workforce that has been out of work for an extended time and/or residents without a high school diploma need basic job soft skills, as well as more specialized training. Participants will have access to a continuum of services to support moving toward gainful employment. The target population will include persons impacted by substance use disorder (SUD), formerly incarcerated individuals, veterans and other members of the community that meet these criteria.
