

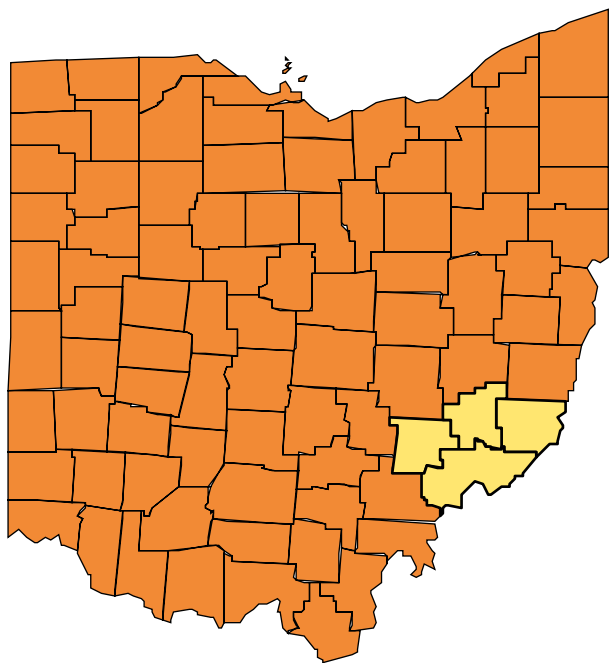

The goal of the WORC grants is to create economic prosperity and gainful employment opportunities for eligible residents in impacted ARC and DRA regions, enabling them to remain and thrive in these communities.

The “Building a Future-Ready Workforce” Program will develop Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) knowledge and career-specific skills for hundreds of high school students from seven partner school districts across four Appalachian Ohio counties, with localized curriculum content, teacher training, in and out-of-school learning experiences, and industry credentials closely coordinated and in alignment with the workforce needs of local industries and employers. “Building a Future-Ready Workforce” will incorporate local manufacturers’ needs into classroom learning, developing career pathways through customized, localized curricula. JASON will coordinate with all of the area partners and stakeholders to develop and deliver curriculum units that align with current and emerging industry sectors, with a focus on the practical, technical, and conceptual skills required to succeed in the region’s advanced manufacturing industries.
