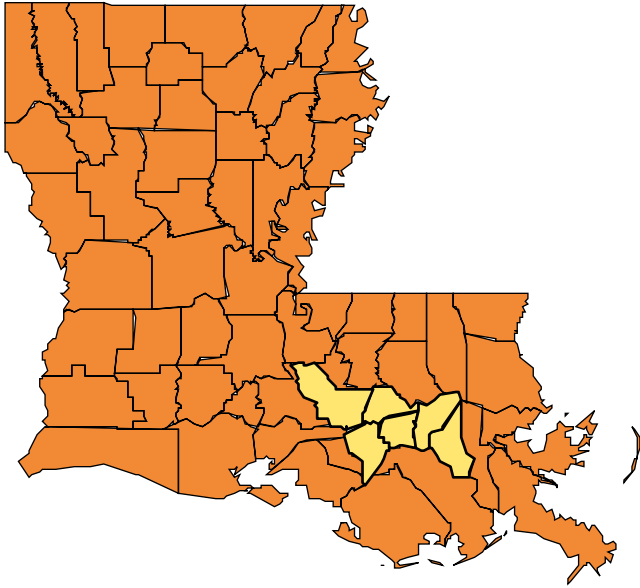

The goal of the WORC grants is to create economic prosperity and gainful employment opportunities for eligible residents in impacted ARC and DRA regions, enabling them to remain and thrive in these communities.

Project P.O.W.E.R. will train new entrants, dislocated workers, and incumbent workers for solar, hydrogen, and wind energy jobs. These are high-wage jobs with increasing demand, due to development projects in Southeast Louisiana and national trends.

Project P.O.W.E.R. will utilize RPCC's new Process Equipment Trainer (PET Plant), a propylene glycol distillation unit that offers hands-on training for students in process technology, instrumentation, and more. RPCC will develop and launch solar, hydrogen, and wind energy training programs.
