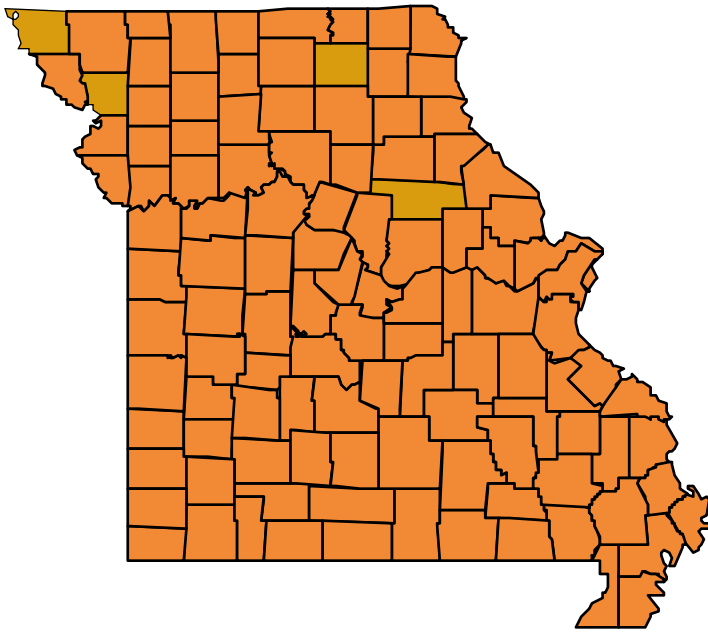

The goal of the WORC grants is to create economic prosperity and gainful employment opportunities for eligible residents in impacted ARC and DRA regions, enabling them to remain and thrive in these communities.

This award provides four concurrent methods of outreach, each intended to support the pipeline of credentialed workers directly into the healthcare industry, prepare dislocated workers for entry into a healthcare occupation, and support incumbent workers in navigating the healthcare career latticework. The project plans to prepare the future workforce in the areas of Certified Nursing Assistants, patient care technicians, transcription, coding, housekeeping, nutritional, maintenance, or similar healthcare occupation within the largely rural Missouri and Ozark healthcare workforce.
