

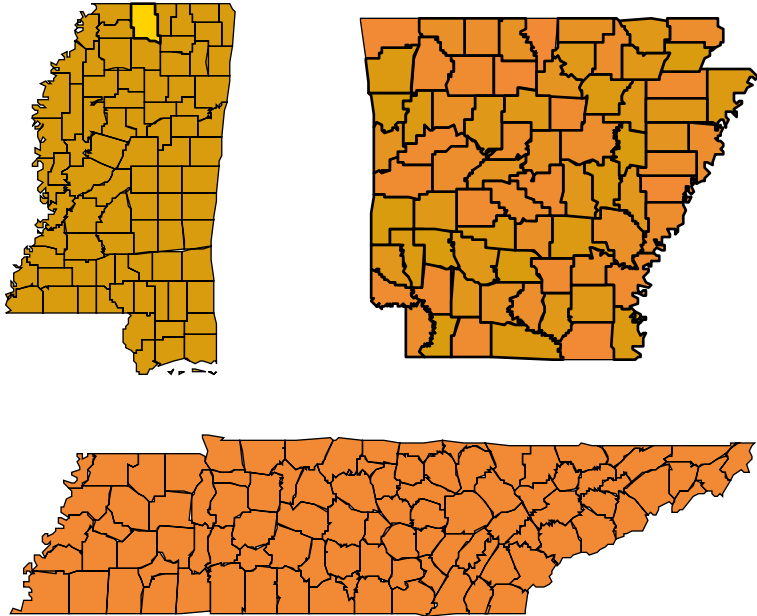

YoWealth Academy is targeting new entrants and dislocated workers by providing a skills- and work-based learning experience leading to high quality employment opportunities in the construction and agricultural sectors. This project intends to prioritize serving historically marginalized communities, specifically Black or African Americans, disconnected youth and those currently unemployed as a result of the Covid 19 pandemic. Since 2014, YoWealth Academy has been preparing at-risk youth in Shelby County, TN. This project has expanded its scope and will continue to offer accelerated, skill-based training programs, and registered apprenticeship programs.
