

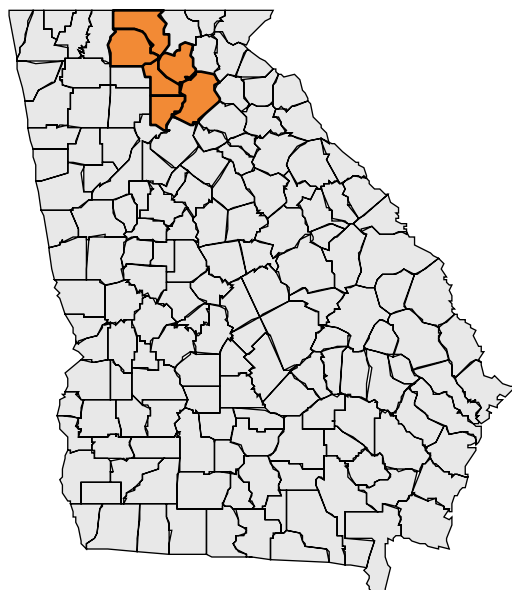

The project will develop a formal curriculum for the advanced entrepreneurship & innovation program for regional replication. The project brings industry and education participants from across the region together for networking and collaboration, and will formally assess local/regional partnership potential for future ecosystem development initiatives.
