## About Us

The purpose of the National Farmworker Jobs Program is to strengthen the ability of agricultural workers, including migrant and seasonal farmworkers, and their dependents, to acquire necessary skills to either stabilize or advance in their agricultural jobs or obtain employment in new industries. Additionally, the program aims to increase access to safe and sanitary housing to assist migrant and seasonal farmworkers and their dependents with achieving their education and career goals, which can lead to improved economic mobility.

## NFJP By the Numbers

- ◆ Approximately \$90 million for career services and training grants
- ◆ In Program Year 2024, 9,054 participants, including 6,081 adults and 2,973 youth, received career services and training
- ◆ Approximately \$6.5 million for housing grants
- ◆ In Program Year 2024, 581 eligible migrant and seasonal farmworker individuals and 966 eligible migrant and seasonal farmworker families received permanent housing services, and 364 eligible migrant and seasonal farmworker individuals and 224 eligible migrant and seasonal farmworker families received temporary housing services
