# **ETP Quality Score Tool User Guide**

### Step 1. ETP users should enter the WIPS-ETP module and click on the "Quality Score Tool" tab.

From here, users may select to test a description for DE106 or DE102:

Eligible Training Provider (ETP)

DE106 - Description of Training Program	DE102 - Description of Training Provider					
Instructions The number one method for increasing the quality score is to provide more detailed information on a program/provider. Adding general words (e.g., "a," the", "is," and" or words that are commonly used in this data set (e.g., "program", "college", "please", "provide") does not increase the quality score. Repeating words from other fields (e.g. provider name or program name) does not increase the quality score. Including more numbers or punctuation will not increase the quality score.						

## Step 2. Determine whether testing DE106 or DE102

**2a. (Testing description for DE106)** If a user clicks on "DE106 – Description of Training Program" they are prompted to enter the text for DE106. Enter the description you would like to test and then click "Submit."

#### 2b. (Testing description for DE102)

**2b.i.** If a User clicks on "DE102 – Description of Training Provider" they are prompted to enter the text for DE102.

**2b.ii.** Once text is entered into the box for DE102, the tool automatically prompts the user to also enter the text for DE101. Enter the text for DE101 as well, then click "Submit." Note that a Quality Score will not be calculated without a response in both fields.
