CRIS results added to INAP & NFJP Reports.

For certain programs, DOL is able to obtain aggregate outcomes using UI wage matches for indicators relating to employment and earnings (Employment Rate Q2, Employment Rate Q4, Median Earnings, and Retention with the Same Employer) through the Common Reporting Information System (CRIS) agreement. In this latest WIPS release, those outcomes will now be added into QPRs submitted by INAP and NFJP grantees starting with reports that were submitted for the report period ending 9/30/2021 moving forward.

These outcomes are obtained and added to QPRs by DOL after the reports have been submitted and certified, and therefore will not be viewable by grantees at the time of submission of their reports. Outcomes for additional programs using CRIS will be added in subsequent releases.
