## **Login.Gov User Migration**

As mentioned in December's WIPS Newsletter, Login.gov has been implemented for full use. Due to a government-wide initiative to move all public access to Login.gov, all external users of WIPS (i.e., grantees) will need to set up their Login.gov account to authenticate into WIPS. Step-by-step instructions have been updated to reflect this change and attached to this newsletter to better assist you in your Login.gov account creation.
