Login.Gov User Migration

As mentioned in November's WIPS Newsletter, Login.gov has been implemented for full use. Due to a government-wide initiative to move all public access to Login.gov, **all external users of WIPS (i.e., grantees) will need to set up their Login.gov account by January 15th, 2022.** In this release, WIPS has simplified the process for users to switch their WIPS accounts over to Login.gov. The step-by-step instructions have been updated to reflect this change and attached to this newsletter to better assist you in your Login.gov account creation. Resetting Your Password

First, make sure your WIPS username is in all **LOWERCASE** letters when attempting to login. If

you still need to reset your password after verifying your username is in all lowercase letters, select **Forgot your password?** on the WIPS login page. From here you will enter in your email address and select **SEND EMAIL.**

Please make sure to check your spam folder if you don't see an email with the subject Password Reset in your inbox. Please note, the email will be sent from Appian and this email will expire in 15 minutes.
