**SUBJECT:** Rescissions of Older Worker Bulletins

1. **Purpose.** To issue rescissions for obsolete Older Worker Bulletins (OWBs) or ones replaced by Training and Employment Guidance Letters (TEGLs).

*\*A new TEGL is issued annually pursuant to poverty guidelines issued by the Department of Health and Human Services. The TEGL gives HHS' poverty levels for the 50 states and territories multiplied by 125%, which represents the income eligibility level for SCSEP participants. This usually occurs in late January or early February.*
