**SUBJECT:** Corrected allotment tables for Revised Program Year 2016 Planning  
Instructions and Allotments for SCSEP National Non-Minority Grantees

1. **Purpose.** This Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) Change 4 provides corrected allotment tables for Non-Minority National grantees for February 1 – June 30, 2017. The participant and funding allotments in Change 3 attachments B-1 and B-2 published on 12/30/2016 contained minor errors for two national grantees, the National Caucus and Center on Black Aged, Inc.
