- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To announce the release and availability of final evaluation reports from the evaluation of the Enhanced Transitional Jobs (ETJ) demonstration and the YouthBuild (YB) program and five study briefs from the Institutional Analysis of American Job Centers (AJCs).

3. Summary and Background.

- a. Summary The Employment and Training Administration (ETA) supported the ETJ demonstration and evaluation, the YB program evaluation, and an analysis of the AJCs. The five study briefs of the Institutional Analysis of AJCs describe key institutional features, resource sharing practices, and service delivery of the AJC system at the time of data collection in 2016.
