1. **Purpose.** To announce the release and availability of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws 2019*.

3. **Summary and Background.**
 - a. Summary – Each year the U.S. Department of Labor publishes a new edition of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws* to reflect changes to state laws and areas of interest.
 - b. Background – The 2019 edition is final. Copies of the *Comparison of State Unemployment Insurance Laws* are mailed to the administrator of each state workforce agency. It also provides an overview of the temporary disability insurance programs operated in six states.
