PURPOSE: To advise apprenticeship staff of Bureau policy regarding unilateral changes to apprenticeship agreements subsequent to registration.

BACKGROUND: The Bureau has been requested to issue a clarifying statement regarding its policy towards one party to an apprenticeship agreement unilaterally making changes affecting the agreement subsequent to registration.

POLICY: It is the policy of the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training that after an apprenticeship agreement has been registered that no party to that agreement may take actions that have the affect of changing that agreement without the consent of the other parties to that agreement including the registration agency. This policy does not preclude termination of agreements by individual signatory participants during a specified probationary period.
