PURPOSE: To advise the BAT Regional Directors that effective immediately they are required to attend several meetings held by the State Apprenticeship Councils (SAC) in their respective Regions during Fiscal Year 1986.

Further, to advise all BAT State Directors that effective immediately they are to make every effort to attend meetings of the State Apprenticeship Council scheduled in their particular State during Fiscal Year 1986.

ACTION:

- (1) BAT Regional and State Directors are directed to submit their views in writing to the Chairman of the Council, or appropriate State official, on all matters which they feel are contrary to existing law or regulations.

If the council is contemplating an action which, while it is not exactly against any law or regulation, and the Regional/State Director feels it is not in the best interest of the program or the apprentice, objections should also be expressed in writing. In both of the above instances, a copy of the written statements will be submitted by the State Director to the Regional Director.

- (2) Once a month, BAT Regional Directors will send copies of the above documents to the BAT Director at the National Office for his review and inclusion in the SAC file.
