AGENCY: Employment and Training Administration, Department of Labor

ACTION: Amendment to FOA-ETA-20-09

SUMMARY: The Employment and Training Administration announced on April 30, 2020, the availability of funds and the Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) for the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) National Grants for Program Year (PY) 2020 grants to be awarded through a competitive process. This amendment to the FOA revises language in Section IV.B.

The document is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION IV.B.4.b. Requested Attachments

Amended Text (new language in bold)

(4) Letters of Commitment or MOUs

Applicants must submit Letters of Commitment or Memoranda of Understanding that describe services, referrals and cost share with key partners; Memoranda of Agreement with key partners that describe the relationship and obligations of each party; signed letter(s) of commitment (not letters of support); and/or signed OJE contracts. Failure to attach these documents will impact scoring of the application. **Please note that an e-mail or other form of written commitment can be used in place of a signed Letter of Commitment, signed Memorandum of Understanding, and/or a signed Memoranda of Agreement.**

When submitting in grants.gov, these letters must be uploaded as an attachment to the application package and specifically labeled “Letters of Commitment.”
