**AGENCY:** Employment and Training Administration, Department of Labor

**ACTION:** Amendment to FOA-ETA-15-02

**SUMMARY:** On December 11, 2014, the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) announced the availability of approximately \$100 million in grant funds authorized by Section 414(c) of the American Competitiveness and Workforce Improvement Act of 1998 (ACWIA), as amended (codified at 29 USC 2916a), for the American Apprenticeship Initiative Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA).

The document is hereby amended as follows:

**Updated Section I. A. Program Purpose**

**This is an amendment to the FOA which removes the reference to foot note 5.**

**Old Text:**
