

Representative Sample, Methodological Rigor

Statistically sound methods

- 7,000 establishments with a 70% response rate
- Represents all U.I. covered employment in Minnesota
- Stratified by region and size for better accuracy

Multiple data collection methods capture data from big, small, tech savvy and very local "mom and pop" establishments

- Paper and on-line surveys
- Collection by analysts from individual company websites
- Automated data scraping from large employers in sample (those that allow it)

Results (30,000 rows of data) are edited and SOC coded using automated tools and checked by analysts for accuracy.


