Private and public sector can cooperate to guarantee labour rights.

## Actions with the value chain



### Policies for productive articulation

They favour social dialogue, public-private articulation and decent work.



*Industrial and technological parks with inter-institutional roundtables foster productive articulation and social dialogue.*



### Good forest management practices

Recommendations to prevent negative impacts and ensure the sustainability of the resource.



*The associations of forest producers provide technical management support and offer advice on certification requirements.*



### Co-responsibility union agreements

Facilitate the registration of workers engaged in rural activities and ensure their access to the social security services. They are social dialogue and management tools that lead to innovations and benchmarking.



### Training and certification of skills

Promote the development of skills and good practices to increase work safety.  
Map the local training gaps and needs.



*Foster professional training partnerships.*



### Working environment, transportation and camps

Identify workers' places of origin and destination to ensure the enforcement of labour regulations and safe working conditions in the forestry sector.



## Actions to reduce decent work gaps



### Policies coordination

- Development of specific databases in the territories
- Articulation and exchange of information between conservation, traceability, labour inspection, and/or areas for the promotion of labour rights
- An all-sectors approach



### Safe and healthy working environment

Increased training and awareness campaigns  
Identify dangerous areas. Explore specific technologies for the sector



### Child and Adolescents' Labour

Assess the existence of child and adolescent labour in each region  
Protection of adolescent workers



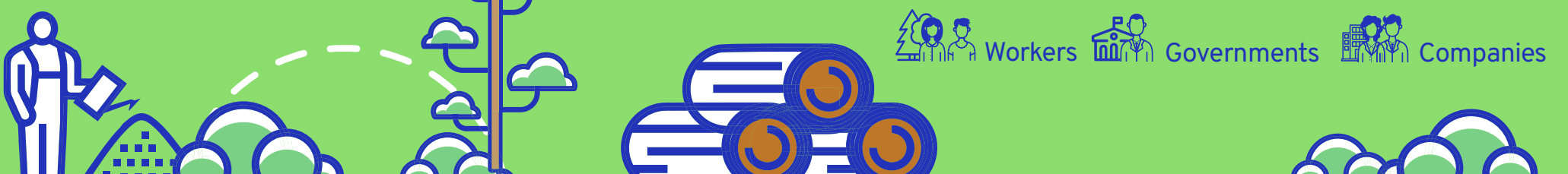
### Discrimination

Promote women's inclusion in the sector  
Foster the integration of indigenous communities



### Labour regime and formalization

Facilitate workers' registration and foster literacy and other programmes to certify workers' competences. Identify irregularities and raise awareness on decent work  
Monitor the working conditions offered by service providers in the forests
