The Ministry of Education, Princeton University, and the NGO, Innovations for Poverty Action (IPA), are conducting research on the opinions of Peruvian students, parents and teachers regarding the importance of education, their expectations for the future, and the use of student time after school. As a Peruvian student, your participation is very important to ensure that the results represent what Peruvian students think about these topics.

What does it mean to participate?

If you are willing to participate, we will ask you a number of questions to learn about your thoughts on education and your expectations for the future. It is possible that we might record a few seconds of a set of three questions that appear at the end of the survey. There are no right and wrong answers. You can decide whether or not to participate in the survey. You are also free to stop at any time, and you can refuse to answer any questions you are not comfortable answering.

How long will participation take?

We hope the survey will last between 60 and 70 minutes.

What are the risks to participating?

There are no risks to participating. There are no right and wrong answers, and your answers will only be shared with the research team.

What are the benefits to participating?

Your participation does not have any direct benefits. The project will contribute to the improvement of the tools used to improve the educational experience of other students.

Is there compensation for participation?

There is no monetary compensation for participating in the study.

What happens to the information that is shared?

The researchers will maintain complete CONFIDENTIALITY with respect to the information obtained in this study. That means that no one will be able to see your answers except for the research team. No one will analyze your answers using your name; you'll only be identified by a number. After the analysis, the results will be published in a scientific journal. Your name will never appear in the publication or any document related to this project.

Is it mandatory to participate? Can you withdraw your consent after the survey begins?

Participation is not mandatory and you can withdraw your consent at any time.
