Stipulated Request for Continuance

Dear Judge Berlin:

Google and OFCCP are writing to request a continuance on the hearing in this matter. This request is based on a stipulation between the parties, whose counsel met and conferred by telephone on February 23, 2017.

Hearing date. The parties respectfully request that the Court continue the hearing date from March 10, 2017 to March 16, 2017. Lisa Sween, Google's lead counsel for the hearing, has a schedule conflict on March 10, 2017. For its part, OFCCP is unable to participate in a hearing on March 10, 2017 due to witness availability.

Pre-hearing statements. Per the Court's February 21, 2017 Notice of Hearing and Pre-Hearing Order, the parties' pre-hearing statements are due February 28, 2017, ten days before the current hearing date of March 10, 2017. The parties respectfully request that the Court continue the deadline on pre-hearing statements to March 6, 2017, which is ten days before March 16, 2017. Additionally, Google's deposition of OFCCP's witness is scheduled for March 3, 2017, per the Court's February 21, 2017 Order Granting in part Google's Request for Limited Discovery Deposition. Moving the deadline on the parties' pre-hearing statements will allow Google to include information obtained from the deposition in the pre-hearing statements.

Witness lists and exhibit lists. Per the Court's Notice of Hearing and Pre-Hearing Order, the parties' witness lists and exhibit lists are due February 28, 2017, ten days before the current hearing date of March 10, 2017. The parties respectfully request that the Court continue the deadline on exhibit lists and witness lists to March 6, 2017, which is ten days before March 16, 2017. Additionally, moving the deadline for exhibit lists and witness lists will allow Google to include information obtained from the March 3, 2017 deposition in the witness lists and exhibit lists.
