Joint Request for Continuation of Stay Pending Mediation

Your Honor:

The parties write to jointly request a continuation of a stay of the litigation to allow the parties to continue focusing their efforts and resources on resolving this matter through mediation.

The parties met with Professor Eric Green for three days of mediation during February 2018. After those mediation sessions, the parties have agreed, along with Professor Green to continue the mediation effort. Given his schedule, Professor Green indicated that he will not be able to reschedule the mediation until April, and we are currently working on rescheduling the mediation for then.

Accordingly, the parties jointly request that the schedule set forth in the Court's October 30, 2017 Order be vacated, and that the stay in the case continue until Monday, April 30, 2018, to give the parties further opportunity to mediate and resolve this case. The parties also propose that they file a case management statement on Friday, April 27, 2018, notifying the Court of the outcome of the parties' mediation efforts, and setting a further case schedule, if necessary.


Both parties are available for a call with the Court next week at a time that is convenient for the Court, should the Court want to discuss the request with the parties.
