ORDER EXTENDING STAY

This matter arises under Executive Order 11246 (30 Fed.Reg. 12319), as amended, and associated regulations at 41 C.F.R. Chapter 60. It is currently set for hearing in San Francisco, California, on November 13, 2018.

On October 30, 2017, the court issued an order staying the proceedings through February 28, 2018, to accommodate the parties' wish to mediate the matter with Professor Eric Green of Resolutions, LLC. The parties now report to the court they have spent three days in mediation and wish to continue mediating with Professor Green, but he is not available to do so until April, 2018.

Accordingly, the court vacates the dates set forth in its Order of October 30, 2017, and extends the stay in this matter through and including April 30, 2018. No later than April 28, 2018, the parties must file a Joint Case Management Statement with the court reporting on their mediation efforts. If they believe the stay should remain in effect, the Joint Case Management Statement must set forth their arguments in support of that position. If the parties have not resolved this matter and do not anticipate further mediation efforts, the Joint Case Management Statement

must set forth a proposed new hearing date no later than January 14, 2019, with proposed interim pre-hearing deadlines.
