ORDER AFTER PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

This matter arises under Executive Order 11246 (30 Fed.Reg. 12319), as amended, and associated regulations at 41 C.F.R. Chapter 60. It is currently set for hearing in San Francisco, California, on August 15, 2017.

The court held a Pre-Hearing Conference on May 9, 2017. Attorneys Laura C. Bremer, Marc A. Pilotin, and Ian H. Eliasoph appeared for Plaintiff Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs, U.S. Department of Labor (OFCCP). Attorneys Warrington S. Parker, III, and Erin M. Connell appeared for defendant Oracle America, Inc. The court, having discussed the matter with counsel, now orders:

1. Effective May 9, 2017, no party may file any motion with the court unless the parties first confer telephonically, with each other and with the court, in a good-faith effort to resolve the issues which are the subject of the proposed motion. The court will summarily deny any Motion filed in derogation of this Order.

2. Effective May 9, 2017, moving papers in support of, or opposition to, any motion are limited to fifteen pages in length, unless the court orders otherwise.

3. The court encourages the parties to meet and confer forthwith in an effort to stipulate to the scope of a Protective Order. The parties must notify the court no later than May 19, 2017, whether they have reached an agreement.

4. The parties' Stipulated Motion Setting Briefing Schedule for Oracle's Motion for Judgement on the Pleadings and OFCCP's Motion re Temporal Scope of Discovery is denied. The parties must file their Opposition to the Motion for Judgement on the Pleadings and the Motion re Temporal Scope of Discovery no later than May 19, 2017. The court will accept no reply pleading in support of either motion.

5. The court sets the following dates in this matter:
