**STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED] ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND

COMPLAINT**

On January 22, 2019, the Court held a status conference in the above-captioned case. Although the Court discussed page limits and briefing schedules in general, the Court continued the conference until February 4, 2019, and has not yet entered an order regarding page and time limits for briefs filed in this case.

IT IS SO STIPULATED.


