Detailed Coverage: The population is all U.S. private-sector establishments on the margin of unionization between 1962 and 2009 as measured by experiencing at least one NLRB certification election during this period. The OSHA enforcement database, records occupational fatalities in U.S. private sector establishments back to 1970.

Study Populations: Adult Workers

Research Method: Quasi-Experimental Design

Sampling Method: Longitudinal unique establishment identifiers for NLRB elections were constructed using a fuzzy-matching algorithm. NLRB and OSHA records were linked at the establishment level using fuzzy-matching, yielding a longitudinal database of all NLRB elections and all of their OSHA enforcement data, including reported occupational fatalities.

peers (e.g., Technical Working Groups), and inputs from relevant DOL agency and program officials and CEO technical staff. Final reports undergo an additional independent expert technical review and a review for Section 508 compliance prior to publication. The resulting reports represent findings from this independent research and do not represent DOL positions or policies.
