This letter is a partial response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted to the United States Department of Labor. The Office of the Solicitor assigned your request to the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) on August 31, 2019. On June 2, 2022, you made a final amendment to your initial FOIA request and requested consolidated Type 2 EEO-1 reports for all federal contractors for reporting years 2016-2020.

Consistent with the U.S. Department of Labor's disclosure regulations at 29 CFR 70.26(j), OFCCP provided notice to contractors covered by this FOIA request through a published Notice in the Federal Register<sup>1</sup>. In addition, it provided notice via an e-mail to all federal contractors for whom OFCCP had contact information, and via the OFCCP website.

To date, the responses we received from contractors include responses from 21 contractors that voluntarily confirmed they had no objection to the release of their entities' EEO-1 data. OFCCP has determined that the data for these 21 contractors is subject to disclosure under FOIA. Please refer to Attachment A for the list and Attachment B for the data.

Since this matter is the subject of FOIA litigation (Docket No. 3:22-cv-07182) in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California, any objections to the interim FOIA releases may be addressed at the appropriate time in the context of the litigation.
