



EDP vs. ECOMP





Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act (EEOICPA) claimants and their Authorized Representatives have two optional online systems available to assist with claims and benefits tasks. The two systems have distinctly different functions and capabilities.

The Energy Document Portal (EDP) is a secure electronic document submission system which includes claim forms, some of which can be electronically signed.

The Employees' Compensation Operations & Management Portal (ECOMP) is a secure online website that provides access to view case information, such as recent actions and compensation information.

The following table highlights the unique capabilities of each system.
