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**Anesthesia Modifiers**

**Effective: June 30, 2021**

Modifiers are two-character indicators used to modify payment of a procedure code or otherwise identify the detail on a claim. Every anesthesia procedure billed to OWCP **must** include one of the following anesthesia modifiers: AA, QY, QK, AD, QX or QZ.

**Anesthesiologist**

<b>Modifier</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Multiple</b>
<b>AA</b>	Anesthesia services personally performed by the anesthesiologist	100%
<b>QY</b>	Medical direction of one CRNA by an anesthesiologist	50%
<b>QK</b>	Medical direction of two, three or four concurrent anesthesia procedures	50%
<b>AD</b>	Supervision, more than four procedures ** Payment to the anesthesiologist will be based on three base units per procedure when the anesthesiologist is involved in furnishing more than four procedures concurrently or is performing other services while directing the concurrent procedure. An additional time unit may be recognized if the anesthesiologist can document that he or she was present at induction.	**

**CRNA**

<b>Modifier</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Multiple</b>
<b>QX</b>	Anesthesia, CRNA medically directed	50%
<b>QZ</b>	Anesthesia, CRNA not medically directed	100%

**Informational (no additional payment for informational modifiers)**

<b>Modifier</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>23</b>	Unusual Anesthesia
<b>47</b>	Regional or general anesthesia provided by the surgeon
<b>QS</b>	Monitored anesthesia care (MAC) services (can be billed by CRNA or physician)
<b>G8</b>	Monitored Anesthesia Care (MAC) for deep complex, complicated or markedly invasive surgical procedure
<b>G9</b>	Monitored Anesthesia Care (MAC) for patient who has history of severe cardiopulmonary condition
<b>P1</b>	A normal healthy patient
<b>P2</b>	A patient with mild systemic disease
<b>P3</b>	A patient with severe systemic disease
<b>P4</b>	A patient with server systemic disease that is a constant threat to life
<b>P5</b>	A moribund patient who is not expected to survive without the operation
<b>P6</b>	A declared brain-dead patient whose organs are being removed for donor purposes
