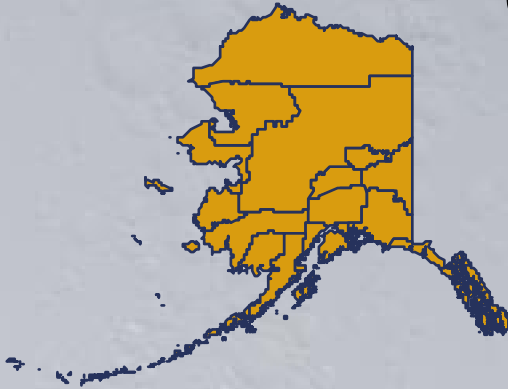

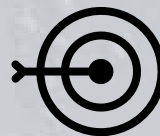
Project Overview

The project plans to serve individuals from historically-marginalized communities or groups. The grantee will prioritize service delivery to Alaska Native/American Indians.



Project Description

The project plans to provide participants with supportive services and training, including internships and apprenticeship programs, to move into higher paying career paths; expand virtual technology applications; create and execute outreach campaigns to priority populations including veterans; and organize and maintain strategic partnerships to optimize use of resources and co-enroll participants.



Project Goals

The proposed project will help move Anchorage AK's Native/American Indian workforce toward high-quality family-sustaining wage employment opportunities and address the economic and workforce challenges caused or exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. The project will take a comprehensive approach to meeting the needs of dislocated workers.
