The plans to serve individuals from historically-marginalized communities or groups and individuals who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted UI or other Pandemic Unemployment Insurance Programs. The grantee will prioritize service delivery to people of color.



Project Description

The project will provide participants with comprehensive career and training activities including career assessment, career advising, one-on-one intensive job search support, resume review, interview preparation and job coaching; expand virtual technology applications and platforms to enhance functionality and provide users with an interactive job platform; create and execute outreach campaigns to address opportunity gaps and resource awareness gaps for marginalized communities; and organize and maintain strategic partnerships with anchor institutions to sustain and enhance grant activities.



Project Goals

This regional project will bridge the gaps of the diverse nature of employment opportunities found in this area. This proposal is focused on bridging the gaps and connecting dislocated workers to multiple training resources and career opportunities that are offered in this area.
