

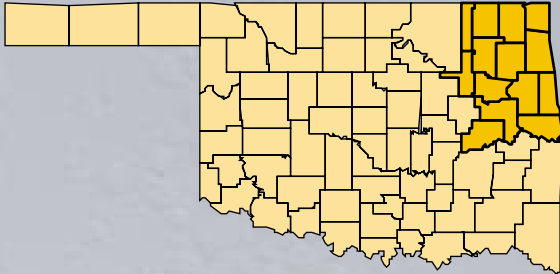

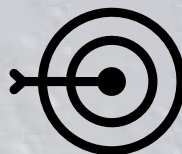
Project Overview
